

Apex School of Theology Public Statement

Apex School of Theology has been informed that at the April 2019 Accreditation Commission meeting of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools, the decision was made for our institution to be deferred for Reaffirmation I and that we are required to Show Cause why our accreditation should not be removed. In March of this year, ASOT was informed of the possibility of this decision; and we have been working diligently since that time to address the outstanding issues.

The concerns centered on assessment, planning and staffing in the finance area. We have made significant changes to our Assessment process as well as improved the process for evaluating and developing our Strategic Plan. We have hired a new Chief Financial Officer who brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to the position. She is working diligently to address the concerns of our accrediting body and making subsequent recommendations to the President and Trustees for approval and implementation. ASOT has also been working very closely with a consulting agency that has over forty years of combined service to higher educational institutions. The staff and administration have been working tirelessly to address the remaining concerns in order to both return to and remain in compliance with the TRACS standards. We fully expect that the hard work and commitment put into addressing these issues will pay off with our removal from Show Cause by the Accreditation Commission.
