### 5. For Discussion:

We have two Commissioners filling partial terms: Dr. Colson (a 1-year public rep for Pearson) and Dr. Audéoud (a 2-yr institution rep for Colson).

The bylaws state that a partial term does not count against the four consecutive terms before a commissioner must take a one-year break from the Commission.

This issue will need to be resolved by the Nominating Committee, but it is not urgent. Since the consecutive term limit is four successive, Dr. Colson can be elected three more times to gain 11 years of service and Dr. Audéoud can be elected two more times before reaching 11 years. The bylaw language is below:

#### Term of Commissioners

The members of the Accreditation Commission shall serve three-year terms, with approximately one-third of the terms expiring each year. A Commissioner may not serve more than four (4) consecutive terms, not including any partial

term served in filling an unexpired term vacancy, after which they may not be eligible for re-election to the Commission for one (1) year.
